


If you are reading this and thinking these curses sure do seem similar to the plight of many black people in the Americas (and all over the world) you would be correct to make this connection. The sign of the curses is visible upon the group of people collectively known as “black America.” Black people in the Americas are part of the dispersed Yasharalite nation. I use the term “black” very generically. Just because a person has dark skin does not necessarily make him a Yasharalite. However, most black people in the Americas have a direct ancestral link to the Trans-Atlantic slave trade. That fact alone stands as a sign of their national identity.

How did Yasharalites end up in the Americas?

Throughout their history, the Yasharalites consistently fled into African countries to escape invasions from other nations and persecution. These migrations took Yasharalites from Egypt to Morocco in the northern part of Africa and from Ethiopia to the countries of the Niger River in the central part of the continent. Hundreds of thousands of these Yasharalites returned “to Egypt in ships,” and were sold to their enemies as slaves.

Overview of the slave trade out of Africa 1500-1900





PART II: BLACK AMERICA’S
NATIONAL IDENTITY**



na·tion·al: of or relating to an entire nation or country

iden·ti·ty: who someone is: the name of a person (group)

Black people are known to be a “religious” people. So let’s use the Bible to help us determine the national identity of black Americans. (There are a multitude of books written about this topic that will validate what the Bible will show. Therefore, search for the truth and you will find it.) The Bible is a book written primarily about black people by black people. The Bible outlines the history of one nation in particular - Yasharal. These Yasharalites were chosen to be a set-apart people unto the Most High Yahuah. However, the Yasharalites chose to walk in disobedience; and, were ultimately dispossessed from their land and **“scattered among all peoples.”** (Deuteronomy 28:64)

In addition to being scattered throughout the earth, the Yasharalites were cursed with a multitude of curses. Moses said these curses **“shall be upon [them] for a sign and for a wonder, and on [their] seed, forever.”** (Deuteronomy 28:46) The curses would be the **identifiable mark** on the Yasharalites. Some of the curses are outlined below.

- **“And as for those of you who are left, I shall send faintness into their hearts in the lands of their enemies, and the sound of a shaken leaf shall cause them to flee. And they shall flee as though retreating from a sword, and they shall fall when no one pursues.”** (Leviticus 26:36)

- **“And you shall perish among the nations, and the land of your enemies shall eat you up, and those of you who are left rot away in their crookedness in your enemies’ lands, and also in their fathers’ crookednesses rot away with them. (Leviticus 26:38-39)**
- **“And you shall be groping at noon, as a blind man gropes in darkness, and not prosper in your ways. And you shall be only oppressed and plundered all the days, with no one to save you.”** (Deuteronomy 28:29)
- **“You become engaged to a wife, but another man does lie with her. You build a house, but do not dwell in it. You plant a vineyard, but do not use its fruit.”** (Deuteronomy 28:30)
- **“Your sons and daughters are given to another people, and your eyes look and fail for them all day long, and your hand powerless.”** (Deuteronomy 28:32)
- **“Thus you shall become an astonishment, a proverb, and a mockery among all the peoples to which Yahuah drives you.”** (Deuteronomy 28:37)
- **“You bring forth sons and daughters, but they are not with you, for they go into captivity.”** (Deuteronomy 28:41)
- **“The sojourner who is among you rises higher and higher above you, but you come down lower and lower. He lends to you, but you do not lend to him. He is the head and, you are the tail.”** (Deuteronomy 28:43-44)

- **“...you shall serve your enemies whom Yahuah sends against you, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in need of all. And he shall put a yoke of iron on your neck until he has destroyed you.”** (Deuteronomy 28:48)
- **“And your life shall be hanging in suspense before you, and you shall fear night and day, and not be certain of your life.”** (Deuteronomy 28:66)
- **“And they have casts lots for My people, and have given a young man for a whore, and sold a girl for wine, and drank it.”** (Joel 3:3)
- **“and the people of Judah and Jerusalem you have sold to the sons of Javan, to remove them far from their borders.”** (Joel 3:6)
- **“And Yahuah shall bring you back to Egypt in ships, by a way of which I said to you, ‘You are never to see it again.’ And there you shall be sold to your enemies as male and female slaves, but no one to buy (redeem).”** (Deuteronomy 28:68)

The twenty-sixth chapter of Leviticus and the twenty-eighth chapter of Deuteronomy outline the curses that would befall the Hebrew Yasharalites if they did **“not obey the voice of Yahuah.”** (Deuteronomy 28:15) Evidence of their fate is also spoken of in the book of Joel. The Yasharalite nation is suffering the effects of these curses to this day.
