

BIRTHRIGHT

birth·right: a particular right of possession or privilege one has from birth, especially as an eldest child

The Creator of the universe is the life-giving source by which all living beings exist. The living that submit themselves to the governance of the Eternal Spirit become children of the Father, Yahuah.

Yahuah's plan of salvation for humanity is the result of His desire to build a house or family of human beings that have been made in His image and His likeness (Genesis 1:28a). Those having come through this process are designated as "sons" of Yahuah. When Yahuah views His children He does not identify us by the color of our skin, but by our nation of origin.

In every family in which there are children, there naturally exists the designation of "firstborn." Is there a firstborn son in Yahuah's house? There is indeed.

"And you shall say to Pharaoh, 'Thus said Yahuah, 'Yasharal is My son, My firstborn, so I say to you, let My son go to serve Me.' (Exodus 4:22-23a)

first·born: (n) a person's first child; (adj.) (of a person's child) the first to be born; the eldest

In these verses Yahuah declares that the nation that descended from Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the Yasharalite nation, is the firstborn of the nations of the earth.

In matters related to the family the firstborn often takes precedence over the rest of the children. That is not to say the firstborn is more important, but refers to the fact that the firstborn precedes the other children in the family in certain experiences.

Furthermore, the firstborn possesses certain rights and responsibilities that are separate and distinct from the other children in the family.

As the firstborn of the nations, Yasharal enjoys certain blessings in Yahuah's house. There were times in the history of the nation that we did enjoy the blessings of our firstborn position. However, there are also certain responsibilities that the Yasharalite nation must execute. This is where we failed; and, that is why we are in the crisis we are in today.

Blessings –

- **The covenant—***"And I (Yahuah) shall establish My covenant between Me and you (Abraham) and your seed after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant to be Alahym to you and your seed after you."* (Genesis 17:7) *"And I shall establish My covenant with [Isaac] for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him."* (Genesis 17:19b)
- **The inheritance of the land—***"And I shall give to you and your seed after you the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession. And I shall be their Alahym."* (Genesis 17:8) *"...from the wilderness, and Lebanon, from the river, the River Euphrates, even to the Western Sea..."* (Deuteronomy 11:24)

- Yasharal would be set high above all the nations of the earth agriculturally, economically, financially, and socially. (Deuteronomy 28:2-13)

Responsibilities –

- Love Yahuah with all our heart, being and might.
- Diligently guard the commands of Yahuah, His witnesses, and His laws which He has commanded us.
- Impress upon (teach) our children to guard the commands of Yahuah.
- To be a **set-apart** people unto Yahuah.
- To **teach** the nations the ways of Yahuah.
- To **lead** the nations of the earth in worship of Yahuah.

Why did Yahuah choose Yasharal?

"And because [Yahuah] loved your fathers, therefore He chose their seed after them..." (Deuteronomy 4:37a) *"Yahuah delighted only in your fathers, to love them. And He chose their seed after them, you above all peoples, as it is today."* (Deuteronomy 10:15)

We are the inheritors of the love, promises and blessings that Yahuah bestowed upon our ancestors, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. We, the seed of Jacob, are bound by the terms of the covenant that the children of Yasharal entered into with Yahuah at Mt. Horeb. That is why it is imperative that we recognize who we are!
