2013 - The Baptist Church Covenant Instructor: Rev. U. D. Williams

Class summary: Explore the design and fundamental study of biblical mandates of our Baptist Church Covenant.

1080 - The Life and Teachings of Jesus Instructor: Rev. Sylvester Johnson

Class summary: Focus on the significance of Jesus' birth, His early life, His teaching ministry, His death and His resurrection.

Textbook: All the Teachings of Jesus, by Herbert Lockyer

1112 - Survey of Revelation Instructor: Rev. Larry Tyler

Class summary: Explore the book of Revelation, with emphases on authorship, date, theme, and recipients. Discuss the prophetic themes, symbols, and interpretations of various revelations.

Textbook: Everyman's Bible Commentary-Revelation by Charles C. Ryrie

7024 - Discovering Your Spiritual Gifts Instructor: Rev. U. D. Williams

Class summary: Help students to understand who God has uniquely made them to be. Work through a spiritual gift assessment that will help them to discover their spiritual gift(s).
